The ECOS Centre Ballymena was originally built as an educational tool for renewable energy and a model of sustainability, however public interest in the project faded over the years and the building became neglected. Works were required to rejuvenate the project, bringing the structure in line with current building regulations as well as breathing life back into the environmental education centre.
